Recently we created an account with the Community Foundation of the Quad Cities. This opened up a State of Iowa Income Tax credit called "Endow Iowa". I would be happy to go over the details, here is the short version:

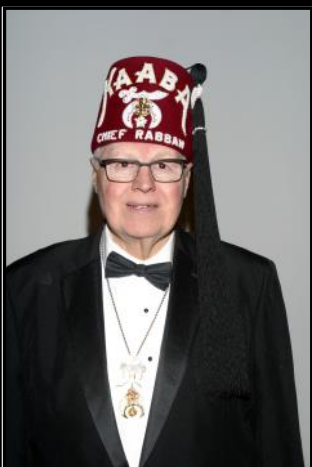
- *Any gift over \$100 qualifies for a 25% state of Iowa income tax credit.*
- *In addition starting April 1, if you give a gift to the Kaaba Agency fund at the Community Foundation of the Quad Cities in an amount over \$1,000.55, you still qualify for the State of Iowa tax credit on that amount and they will match your contribution to Kaaba's fund (...up to a maximum of \$10,000 or until funds for this special run out).*
- *So \$2,000 in our account and it only cost the donor \$750 after the tax credit!!*

Remember Kaaba and Shriners Hospitals in your estate plans, it is easy to do any amount, call me if you need ideas.

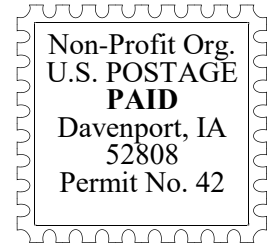
