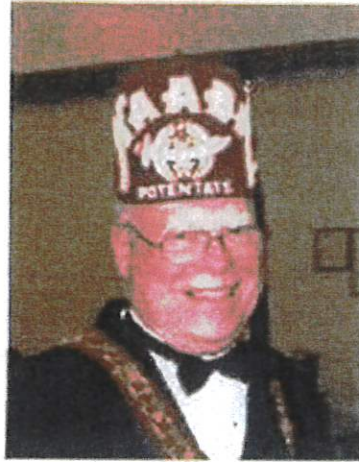

Hospital Notes for 28 March 2023

For the month of February 2023, the Shriners Children Chicago location was busy as ever.

There were 100 surgeries and 14 of those being spine, and 61 outpatient surgeries, on site visits were 1,269, below the budgeted of 1,400. Surgeries totaled 22,169 minutes. Telehealth visits were down to only 20 and the budget has allowed for 50, so more usage of this service is needed. Chicago saw 161 new patients and only 44 were discharged. Operating expenses for the facility was over 4 million dollars for February. Statistics for February are in line with the number of operating days, being 20 days. Plans are to open the 4th operating room by April, but still need to hire nursing staff to fill all positions. We are still having two to three employees testing positive for COVID every week. The facility will continue to require masks for everyone at this time.

Requests have been sent out for bids to replace the lobby doors and have them comply with handicap accessibility; the price tag is expected to be around 38,000 dollars. This number could change as labor and material costs increase. The amount of dollars spent maintaining the front doors has exceeded 40% of replacement cost. Security within the parking lots has been reviewed and the estimated price tag is 57,500 dollars. Home office of Tampa has requested that all parts of securing the parking lot be bundled together and resubmitted back for approval

Chicago's Dr. Silver was featured in Chicago Health Magazine both for her skill as a doctor and her art work applied on patient casts. The Washington Post has an article in their newspaper, story was pick up in the Huston Chronicle and Seattle Times. All this caught the attention of NBC Nightly news and CBS Evening news. Release needs to be completed before story can be broadcast.

Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) and Computer Tomography (CT) Imaging to Shriners Children's Chicago has expected a cost of 2.5 million dollars over a 3-year timeline. At the present time, Chicago must send a patient by ambulance to another location which can take up to 1.5 hours to get there, along with a nurse to stay with the patient to receive their MRI or CT. During a complex spine surgery, this is necessary to make sure that everything is correctly aligned. Shriners Children's Chicago mission, vision, and strategic plan is serving children with complex and specialized healthcare needs. Chicago is also evolving into a destination center for complex spine and craniofacial surgeries.

At the present time Chicago is doing infusion for patients, but each infusion is using a private room stressing the nursing staff. The proposed new fusion center will have a nursing station and 4 beds in it. This reduces the need for the nursing staff to move from room to room just to check on a patient's progress. The new proposed location will have curtains that can be drawn to provide privacy when required and open other times to let the attending staff view and monitor multiple patients at the same time. The time line is August this year, awaiting Imperial approval. Several other locations already have similar facilities.

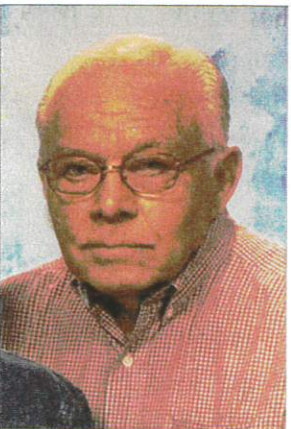
Marvin L. Rursch April 7, 2023

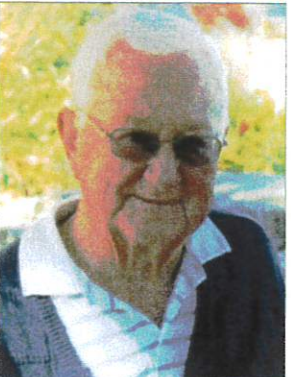
Laverne Messer February 3, 2023

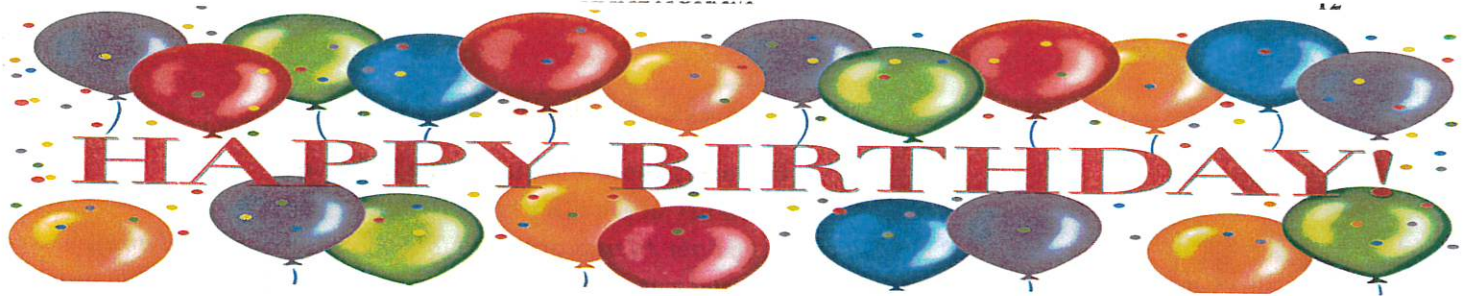
Edward Rudolph Garrett March 7, 2023
