## SHRINERS HOSPITAL REPORT

What has changed at Shriners Children Hospital (SHC) over the past year? When we look back at all the changes that have happened, it would be hard to pick out just one major event. The biggest event, in my opinion, is the arrival of our hospital administrator, Mr. Craig McGhee, not only is he the SHC administrator but also the Midwest Market administrator. He oversees how the Midwest Market is working to see more kids in more locations at a lower overall cost. He must overlook the big Midwest Market, which is from Chicago to Twin Cities to Boys' Town in NE, to St. Louis and also to Dayton, Ohio as joint members which covers nine different states. Children are being taken care of and even though sometimes the transportation travel is long, the results are exceptional.

When looking at the number of patients served, SHC is not the leader, but when looking at other locations, one cannot compare numbers because not all locations may have the specialty doctors on staff there to perform that necessary care, for instance, look at the Mexico hospital, I understand that they perform services 24/7 because of the number of patients requesting care. California is another location where the number of patients is growing. All the Shriners Hospitals are reviewed and adjustments are made by the Imperial Shrine Hospitals Board of Governors to ensure that every location is doing their best work. Some locations have been made into Clinics with services offered and a hospital close by where our Shriner Doctors can work their magic.

SHC has made their Donation Campaign goal for 2023. The goal was set at 6 million dollars in January of 2023, and the final numbers came in as \$6,303,700.42. Good job and thank you to all who helped.

Some numbers that normally are not looked at are the 12-month totals, SO for 2023: Admissions – 509, discharges- 508. We always talk about spine because Chicago is the Midwest location to have spinal surgeries. – 149, that's about 12 per month or 4 per week. Outpatients' surgeries – 759, those not required to stay overnight. Total of all surgeries - 1,231. New examinations - 2,187, that's over 8 exams per working day, all this does not include Rehabilitations. Physical Therapy saw 10,958 patients. Occupational Therapy saw 4,370 individuals, and Speech Therapy saw 1,275 patients. All these patients have kept SHC very busy.

What is happening around the grounds to keep the SHC facility up to date: the lobby doors have been replaced and the lobby entrance is being updated. Appearance is important to both the community and the patients. The SHC laundry room has been decommissioned due to the fact that SHC no longer does their own laundry. A cost-effective measure was undertaken. The laundry equipment has been sold to the company that does the Hospital laundry and we are receiving monies back. External security has been upgraded because of some individuals that have entered Hospital property and removed items that did not belong to them. Upgrading of security cameras and more patrols have been implemented.

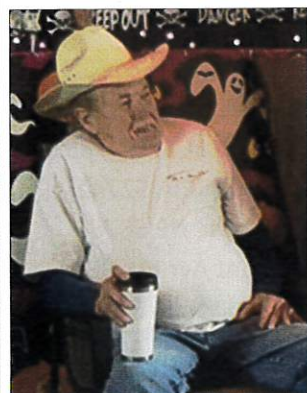
Patrick E. Burke    October 21, 2023

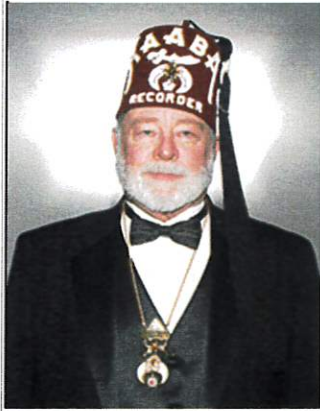
