Notes from Shriners Children's Chicago Board meeting 24 June 2025.

The June Board Meeting was conducted on 24 June 2025 at the Hospital. With a special board meeting at 9 AM, that was shortened so that a special 100th year Cornerstone Laying Program could be conducted. With special invitations being sent to each Masonic Center that supports Chicago, several Divan members of some of those centers were in attendance. After the normal Board meeting, a program was presented to all people invited to be there. The presentation consisted of how Chicago began and what it has become. In attendance were four former patients that told their stories. One lady relayed how she contracted Polio and the treatment she received from around the 1940 period. Looking at her walk, you would never have guessed that she had had Polio. One Gentleman related how his hands and fingers had been separated from being webbed and how he had served 20 years in the Navy and had become micro-equipment qualified. His goal was to give back to the Shriners and Hospital for all he had received. Today he is a Shriner and a Chicago Associate Board Member. All the guest speakers spoke of how their lives have changed because of what the Shriners had done for them. One even spoke of how he did not have a medical problem (osteogenesis imperfecta or brittle bone disease) but an inconvenience and to just deal with it. He is now a professional opera singer and did a beautiful job singing the National Anthem before the program began.

Some good news for individuals going to Shriners Children's Chicago. Project WI-FI now has network expansion completed to cover 99% of the hospital. This improvement will help with receiving medical records and within overall communications of all workers. It has gone from the previous 50% to now 99%. May patients' numbers. Surgeries: 116, in May all the surgeries came from 44 inpatients and 72 outpatients. On-site clinic visits were 1,678 individuals. New patients were 247. Rehabilitation visits were 1,523. Chicago is receiving patients from other hospitals that do not have the capabilities in children's orthopedics that Shriners Children's Chicago has.
